

Advocacy Officer

Banks must be pro-active in engaging with lawmakers and regulators. Ensure your bank's story is told by designating an employee to serve as an Advocacy Officer.

Advocacy Officers are the first point of contact for MBA. They are responsible for sharing advocacy opportunities with bank employees, including:

- Urgent legislative and regulatory action alerts;
- Target Banker visits with state legislators in Jefferson City;
- Annual Washington visits with federal regulators and members of Congress;
- Local meetings with lawmakers and candidates.

Advocacy Officers will receive exclusive access to a quarterly Missouri political update, special breakout sessions at MBA's Annual Convention, and recognition for their service to the industry.
